## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City Council of the City of Industry will conduct a public hearing concerning the application for a revised plan of development for the Industry Business Center (IBC) project. The IBC site consists of 592 acres in the eastern portion of the City of Industry north of the Pomona Freeway (SR-60) and the Orange Freeway (SR-57), and south of Valley Boulevard. In 2004, the City Council of the City of Industry certified an Environment Impact Report for a plan of development for the IBC site that divided the property into conceptual planning areas and proposed the development of up to 4.8 million square feet of built space, including 633,000 square feet of industrial uses, 1,268,000 square feet of retail uses, and 2,878,000 square feet of office uses. The revised IBC plan of development would eliminate the conceptual planning areas and establish a plan of development that would reduce the total square footage of office, retail, and industrial space on the IBC site by approximately 1,669,000 square feet. The revised plan of development would include a National Football League stadium with practice fields, training facilities, team office and a sports medical center. The revised plan of development also includes entertainment uses, office buildings, restaurants, retail uses, and parking areas to accommodate all such uses.


