Dispose of old paint, batteries, e-waste or motor oil the right way. The next household hazardous waste and E-waste collection event is scheduled for Saturday, February 25, 2017 from 9:00 am-3:00 pm at the 1300 block of Bridge Gate Drive, Diamond Bar. Examples of items you can bring to the event: computer monitors, televisions, printers, paint, paint thinner, brake fluid, motor oil, oil filters, expired pharmaceuticals, anti-freeze, and fluorescent light bulbs.

## Free bulky item pick up

The City of Diamond Bar's two franchise waste hauler offer residents a free residential bulky item collection program. Oversized or overweight household articles such as stoves, water heaters, rugs, washing machines, mattresses, as well as electronic waste are some of the frequently requested items. Residents are allowed up to four (4) free pick-ups annually.

The bulky item collection service is available to single family homes and multifamily residential units. To ensure the best service, *pick-ups must be scheduled in advance.*

## Beverage container recycling

For a limited time and while supplies last, the City is providing free beverage container recycling bins to Diamond Bar schools looking to start or improve a school recycling program.
