Holiday tree recycling program



Each year, the City's franchise haulers Waste Management and Valley Vista Services operate a free holiday tree recycling program from December 26 through the second Sunday in January. During this time, residents may place holiday trees out for collection. Trees must be free of tinsel, garland, and ornaments, and have their stands removed. Please do not place trees in plastic bags. All trees are diverted from the landfill.

Waste Management customers may place additional refuse out for collection in containers (bags, boxes, barrels, etc.) at no charge for two (2) weeks beginning each December 26.

This service is limited to refuse that could otherwise be placed in the refuse cart, and not bulky items. Bulky items may be scheduled by contacting Waste Management at 1.800.266.7551 or Valley Vista Services at 800.442.6454.

Recycling at the Eco Expo

The City of Diamond Bar held the annual Eco Expo on Saturday, November 14 at AQMD. As a result of this annual event, Diamond Bar residents were able to conveniently recycle electronics and household textiles, and participate in free document shredding services and free garden compost courtesy of Waste Management.

The Diamond Bar community participated in record numbers this year, assisting the City to divert 9,557 pounds of e-waste, 786 pounds of textiles and 9,440 pounds of paper!
