INFORMATION PACKET

This 8 week program is designed to teach the skills and fundamentals of basketball to children ages 4-13 in a fun, safe, and recreational environment. Practices will begin the second week in January and will be conducted by volunteer coaches, one day per week, for one hour. Games will be played at South Pointe and Chaparral Middle School Gymnasiums or Mt. Calvary Lutheran School. All games will be played on Saturdays between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., from January 19 through March 9, 2019.

Diamond Bar Residents: September 10, 2018

Non-Residents: September 24, 2018

Registration Fee:

Diamond Bar Residents: \$99 per participant (Proof of residency required at time of registration.)

Non-Residents: \$104 per participant

Registration will continue until program is full.

Registration will not be accepted without a signed waiver, signed parent's code of ethics and verification of age for each child. Registration fee includes team jersey and participation medal.

Refunds:

All request for refunds must be made in writing to the Parks and Recreation Department. All request must be made prior to the first game. Refunds are subject to a \$15 processing fee and the team jersey must be returned before refund is issued.

New Division Formation! The division participants will be placed in will be determined based on their age as of January 12, 2019.

Five divisions 4-5, 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, and 12-13 years old.

- Contract officials for division's 6-7 and up.
- 10 players per team.

Parents & Coaches Meet & Greet Nights: All meetings will take place at City Hall - Windmill Room (21810 Copley Drive – 1st floor). All parents and participants are encouraged to attend. This event will provide an opportunity for your child to meet their coach and other players on their team. At the meeting, team names will be picked and jerseys will be distributed.

Coaches Meeting: December 18 at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall – Windmill Room (21810 Copley Drive – 1st floor). This meeting will cover division rules, substitution information, and game and practice locations and schedules. Please note that practice time slots will be selected at the meeting. Priority for selection will go as follows: 4-5, 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, and 12-13 year old divisions. Example, all of the 4-5 year old teams will pick their time slot first, then 6-7 and so forth.

Skills Day: December 1, 2018 at South Pointe Middle School

All registered players must attend skills day. 4-5 year old division players do not need to attend skills day. Teams are formed by random selection.

Practice Locations & Times:

Practices will be held at South Pointe Middle School and Mt. Calvary Lutheran School. Practice times will be between the hours of 6 to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Practice times and dates are determined by the coaches after the teams have been formed

Game Locations & Times

Games will be played at South Pointe and Chaparral Middle School Gymnasiums or Mt. Calvary Lutheran School. All games will be played on Saturdays between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., from January 19 through March 9, 2019.

Who are the coaches?

Our program is supported by parent/adult volunteers. If you are interested in serving as a coach or an assistant coach, please notify recreation staff at 909.839.7076.

What is provided with registration?

Each participant registration includes: a team jersey and a participation medal.

When is Picture Day?

Picture day will be on January 12, 2019. Pictures are optional to purchase, they are not included in your registration price. Picture day schedule and locations will be available the first week of practice.

Do we keep score and standings?

This is a recreational program, the score will be kept throughout the game, but we do not keep standings. Score will only be kept if the teams are within 15 points of each other. Once a team is more than 15 points ahead the scoreboard will be turned off and the score will no longer be kept.

Can my children play together on the same team?

Siblings who live in the same household and play in the same age division will always be placed on the same team. Children are allowed to play "up" one division (play in an age division above), however they are not allowed to play "down" a division. Please indicate the division you would like your child to play in on the registration form.

May I request that my child be placed with the same coach as last year? Or on the same team as a friend?

The premise of this program is to have balanced teams where an emphasis is placed on children having fun, interacting with peers, sportsmanship and experiencing different coaching styles. However, if you have a special request they must be made prior to December 1, and must be in writing attached to the registration form. All request will be evaluated, but ultimately the decision is made by City staff based on the best interest of the program.

When are games held?

Games are played on Saturdays, any time between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., depending on the number of teams in each division. Parents will receive a schedule of games from coaches, soon after teams are formed.

What size rim do they play on?

- 4-5 years old 6 foot rim.
- 6-7 years old 8 foot rim.
- 8-13 years old 10 foot rim.

What size ball do they use?

- 4-7 year olds 27.5 size ball.
- 8-13 year olds 28.5 size ball.

Illness & Immediate Medical Attention

Should your child become ill or (minor – non life threatening) injured during practices or games, and Parents/legal guardians are not on site. Parents/legal guardians will be called to pick up their child. If parents/legal guardians are not available, staff will contact individuals listed on the emergency form.

If a child needs immediate medical attention, the following steps will be taken. Emergency Medical Assistance (911) will be called. Staff will then make every attempt to contact a parent/legal guardian if not on site. If they cannot be reached, attempts to contact persons listed on the emergency form will be made. If the child needs to be taken to the hospital by an emergency vehicle, neither the City of Diamond Bar nor recreation staff will assume any financial responsibility for this action or other medical fees.

- I will place the emotional & physical well being of my child & all other children ahead of my personal desire to win. ____

- I understand that children play sports to have fun, make friends, and to learn new skills, therefore I will praise effort as well as execution in order to keep sports in the proper perspective. ____

- I will support the game officials at all times, even if I do not agree with a call, because their presence is to make the game safe, fun, and fair for the children that are playing. ____

- I will remember that the game I am attending is for the players & not for me or any other spectator. ____

- I will support a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, & alcohol & will refrain from their use at all games and events in the City of Diamond Bar. ____

- I understand that any and all of my actions are subject to review by the City of Diamond Bar's Recreation staff. ____

I fully understand & completely accept the standards of behavior outlined previously.
