




****CONSTRUCTION NOTICE****

CONSTRUCTION BEGINS ON EASTBOUND OFF-RAMP AND WESTBOUND ON-RAMP OF THE SR-60/LEMON AVENUE INTERCHANGE PROJECT



WHAT

As part of the State Route 60/Lemon Avenue Interchange Project, the Alameda Corridor-East Construction Authority (ACE), on behalf of the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and in conjunction with the Cities of Diamond Bar and Industry, will commence construction of an eastbound off-ramp and westbound on-ramp on State Route 60 at Lemon Avenue to improve traffic flow and reduce congestion in the area.

WHAT TO EXPECT

ACE contractors will begin clearing the work area of brush and trees in preparation for construction of the freeway ramps. Portions of the freeway sound wall within the work area will be temporarily removed during construction. Some noise, dust and vibration may be noticeable. Access to local businesses and residences will be maintained. Motorists and pedestrians are urged to obey posted signs and to exercise caution while in the vicinity of construction activity.

WHEN

Work is scheduled to begin **Monday, November 28, 2016** and is expected to continue for approximately 16 months. Most work will occur weekdays between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
