




****COMMUTER ALERT****

POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) EASTBOUND OFF-RAMP AT BREA CANYON RD. TO PERMANENTLY CLOSE ON MARCH 31; NEW EASTBOUND OFF-RAMP AND WESTBOUND ON-RAMP AT LEMON AVE. OPENS



WHAT

As part of the State Route 60/Lemon Avenue Interchange Project, the Alameda Corridor-East Project (ACE), on behalf of the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and in conjunction with the Cities of Diamond Bar and Industry, will permanently close the eastbound Pomona Freeway (SR-60) off-ramp at Brea Canyon Road. Simultaneously, the newly constructed eastbound SR-60 off-ramp and westbound SR-60 on-ramp at Lemon Avenue will open to traffic.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Eastbound SR-60 motorists will have access to the newly constructed Lemon Avenue off-ramp, in addition to the existing adjacent Fairway Drive and Grand Avenue off-ramps. The westbound SR-60 on-ramp at Brea Canyon Road remains open. The new on- and off-ramps at Lemon Avenue were built to improve traffic flow on the freeway mainline, reduce traffic weaving and improve safety.

WHEN

The Brea Canyon Road off-ramp closure and simultaneous Lemon Avenue on- and off-ramp opening will occur on **Saturday, March 31, 2018 at 7:00 a.m.**
