




****UPDATED COMMUTER ALERT****

NEW STATE ROUTE 60 EASTBOUND OFF-RAMP AND WESTBOUND ON-RAMP AT LEMON AVE. OPENS ON MAY 1; EASTBOUND OFF-RAMP AT BREA CANYON RD. TO PERMANENTLY CLOSE



WHAT

As part of the State Route 60/Lemon Avenue Interchange Project, the Alameda Corridor-East Project (ACE), on behalf of the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and in conjunction with the Cities of Diamond Bar and Industry, the newly constructed Pomona Freeway (SR-60) eastbound off-ramp and westbound on-ramp at Lemon Avenue will open to traffic. Simultaneously, the eastbound SR-60 off-ramp at Brea Canyon Road will be permanently closed. The new on- and off-ramps at Lemon Avenue were built to improve traffic flow on the freeway mainline, reduce traffic weaving and improve safety.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Eastbound SR-60 motorists will have access to the newly constructed Lemon Avenue off-ramp, in addition to the existing adjacent Fairway Drive and Grand Avenue off-ramps. The westbound SR-60 on-ramp at Brea Canyon Road remains open.

WHEN

The Lemon Avenue on- and off-ramp opening and the permanent eastbound Brea Canyon Road off-ramp closure will occur on **Tuesday, May 1, 2018 between 5 a.m. and 7 a.m.**
