BACKGROUND:

The City Council has initiated two concurrent assessment district ballot proceedings to replace existing District Nos. 39 and 41. Proposition 218, adopted by California voters in 1996, imposes certain procedural and substantive requirements related to assessments, and allows municipalities to adopt specific ballot procedures. The Resolution would establish and memorialize the specific procedures for this process.
