## City Suspends Street Sweeping Citations

(Diamond Bar, CA, March 18) – Effective March 16, 2020, the City will not issue parking citations for street sweeping infractions in residential areas until April 30, 2020.

"In light of the direction given by Governor Newsom related to COVID 19, we hope the suspension of street sweeping parking enforcement will help support those that are staying home practicing social distancing to prevent the spread of the virus", said Mayor Steve Tye.

During the suspension, street sweepers will continue to maintain their schedules and residents are asked to move vehicles, if possible, during their neighborhood's scheduled street sweeping day and time. All other parking laws will be enforced.
